Prerequisites: None. Subjects in this course will be covered in the Basic Backpacking Course. This Course is NO longer a prerequisite for Basic Backpacking.

Who should attend: Any registered adult Cub and any registered Scout leaders who organize day hikes and car-camping trips for their unit. Backpacking will not be covered.

What to Bring: Scout Uniform Class "A", writing instrument and paper. We will break for the University lunch period from 12:00 P.M. to 1:00 P.M.
